

## Small Welsh School Fund (SWSF) for Hyb

**For one pound a week you can help generate  
research in support of small schools**

**And help raise a total of £52,000 by *Tuesday 30 November***

**Who is organising this fund?** The Small Welsh Schools Fund (SWSF) was set up in January 2005 to support efforts to safeguard the future of small schools in Wales. Since inception the fund has paid £15,400 as prize money. A full list of winners can be viewed from the original website [www.acwss.org.uk](http://www.acwss.org.uk). The Association of Communities in Wales with Small Schools (ACWSS) established SWSF fund. ACWSS is made up of the Campaign for the Protection of Rural Wales (CPRW), The Farmers Union of Wales (FUW), Wales YFC, Merched y Wawr, NFWI-Wales and the Small Welsh Schools Fund (SWSF -The Fundraising Arm of ACWSS). The association aims to promote the benefit and opportunity of community and social development in areas of Wales with small schools.

**Why is Hyb involved now?** ACWSS has now joined forces with recently established Hyb (Hyrwyddo Ysgolion Bach:Promoting Small Schools). The SWSF is being extended so that it can support the initiatives of Hyb who are carrying out essential research in to the benefits of small schools ([www.hyb.org.uk](http://www.hyb.org.uk)). The money gathered from SWSF activity will be used by Hyb to continue to conduct in-depth research. Such evidence is vital when challenging the closure of small schools.

**How does the SWSF (Hyb) fund work?** Small Schools Fund in Wales works through individual contributions of £1 a week through a standing order. There are 13 prizes every quarter of up to a total of £700 - this increases in line with new membership. To start the contributions flowing into the fund there is an initial £6 administration fee.

**How does to the quarterly prize draw work?** We ensure all professional systems are put in place to provide all members with confirmation of their Draw Number. Quarterly e-bulletins are circulated to inform fund members of the winners and the good work being achieved with their support.

**The benefits of growing the fund** - By working together we can achieve great results and assist in saving small Welsh Schools who wish to remain open and a central part of their community across the country. The more members we gain the greater the resources that can be devoted to generating research on the benefits of small schools. It also serves to raise awareness of the issues of small schools across Wales.

**What's the target?** We are looking for 50 promoters across Wales to raise a total £52,000 of annual pledges by **Tuesday 30 November** to coincide with the Royal Welsh Winter Agricultural Fair.

The fund pays a £5 commission to a promoter for every form that is returned to us with a completed mandate - every 20 forms generate a commission of £100 for your time and efforts - 200 forms from a school, large club or association will raise an invaluable £1,000.
